With our partners we work to assist Veterans and their families struggling with their emotional well-being and having difficulty connecting to services.

VOW 9-Line assists with support efforts including:

- ⇒ **Safe storage** of medication and firearms
- ⇒ **Mental health** access for yourself or a family member
- ⇒ **Food** insecurities—We can help provide you with access to food pantries
- ⇒ **Homelessness** or risk of homelessness—we provide housing in our tiny home village to help you get back on your feet.
- ⇒ **Employment**—Are you unemployed? Underemployed? We can connect you with employment training and employers near you.
- ⇒ **VA services**—Are you connected to the VA? We can get you connected for your health or mental needs.

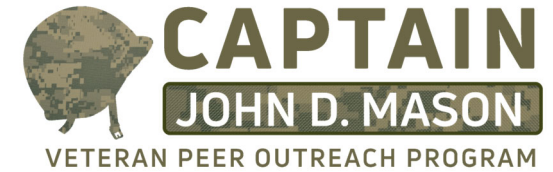
- ⇒ **Peer Support**—Have you been looking for a Veteran led support group? We can connect you.
